

Getting to your appointments

Parking program overview:

The Mass General Radiation Oncology Parking Program enables patients undergoing radiation therapy to either self-park in one of the hospital garages or use the Yawkey valet at a discounted rate. Only patients currently undergoing treatment multiple times per week are eligible. Once treatment is complete, regular patient parking rates will apply.

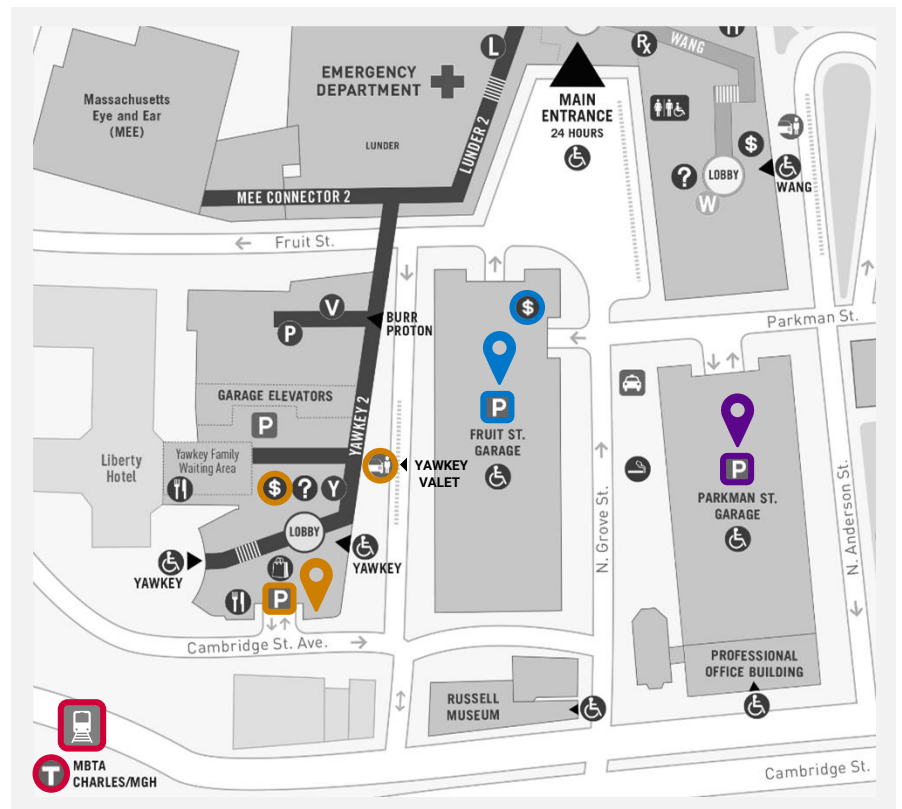
Patients must obtain a parking slip from the front desk staff listing the dates of the patient appointments (at least two per week) to set up the reduced parking rate.

Self-park option:

Please bring the parking slip you received from the front desk to the MGH Parking Office, located in the **Fruit Street garage**. You will be charged a discounted rate for the number of visits listed and a garage access card (valid at the **Fruit, Parkman, or Yawkey Street garages**) will be programmed for you.

Yawkey valet option:

Please bring the parking slip you received from the front desk to the Yawkey Cashiers Office, located in the **Yawkey Building Lobby**. Valet coupons may be purchased for each visit. Upon arrival, patients and their caregivers should pull up to the **Yawkey Valet** to drop off their vehicle and receive a valet ticket. When leaving, the patient or caregiver should affix the pre-purchased coupon to the ticket and go to the Yawkey valet podium. Kindly allow 5 to 10 minutes for retrieval.



Public transportation:

Mass General Hospital can be easily accessed via the **MBTA Redline**. When exiting the **Charles/MGH** stop, cross the street towards the Liberty Hotel and enter through the Yawkey Building.

The RIDE paratransit service provides door-to-door, shared-ride transportation to eligible people who can't use the subway, bus, or trolley all or some of the time due to temporary or permanent disability. Contact The RIDE Eligibility Center (TREC) at (617) 337-2727, or email trec@paratransit.org.
