James K. DeOrio, MD is currently a Professor of Orthopedics at Duke University Medical Center in Durham, NC and Associate Professor Emeritus, Mayo Clinic College of Medicine in Jacksonville, FL.

Dr. DeOrio is the former Director of the Foot and Ankle Fellowship and was Chairman of the Orthopedic Department at the Mayo Clinic, in Jacksonville, FL for over 15 years. He is a 1977 graduate of the George Washington University School of Medicine in Washington, DC. He trained at the Mayo Clinic and did an AO Fellowship in Chur, Switzerland in 1983.

Dr. DeOrio is a frequent contributor to orthopedic research with over 110 original articles and additional book chapters. From the AOFAS he is the recipient of the J. Leonard Goldner Basic Science Award and is a two time winner of the Roger Mann Award for Clinical Science. He has performed over 1300 ankle replacements; up to three per day and seven per week. In February 2012, in recognition of his achievements, he ranked in the top 1% in the nation in the foot and ankle specialty and top 20 Surgeons in North Carolina. Also in 2012, he was elected by his peers in US News as one of the 23 Top Foot & Ankle Surgeons in the U.S.

He is a 1970 graduate of the US Air Force Academy and proud former member of the Falcon football team. Dr. DeOrio is also a retired Colonel in the US Air Force.
