**David N. Bernstein, MD, MBA, MEI** is a current orthopaedic surgery resident in the Harvard Combined Orthopaedic Residency Program (HCORP) based out of Massachusetts General Hospital and a senior researcher (contractor) at the Institute for Strategy and Competitiveness at Harvard Business School, where he collaborates with Professor Michael E. Porter on value-based health care initiatives. His scholarly endeavors focus on the practical implementation of value-based health care principles, the routine collection and use of patient reported outcome measures (PROMs), the determination of the true cost of care delivery, and efforts to address disparities in orthopaedic care as part of ongoing health care system transformation efforts. To date, David has published over 110 peer-reviewed manuscripts in top scientific journals, co-authored a variety of opinion pieces and commentary articles in popular mainstream media outlets, received numerous prestigious accolades for his scholarly activity, and spoken globally on addressing health care system challenges.

David received his Doctor of Medicine (MD) with Distinction in Research from the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry and his Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Simon Business School at the University of Rochester, where he was elected to the Beta Gamma Sigma honor society. In addition, he holds his Master in Entrepreneurship and Innovation with Distinction from the University of Luxembourg as a Fulbright Scholar. His Bachelor of Arts (AB) in Economics is from Bowdoin College. He is currently earning his Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in value-based health care from the University of Leiden in The Netherlands.

David lives in Boston, MA with his beautiful wife, Dr. Kate Bernstein, a current pediatrics resident in the Boston Combined Residency in Pediatrics (BCRP) based out of Boston Children’s Hospital/Harvard and Boston Medical Center/Boston University.
